

THE PLACE: FOLDSÆ



The place for the conference is Foldsæ educational centre. It has been a farming school since the 60ies, now it house a Waldorf (high)school for biodynamical agriculture and the courses of the international Master degree Programme in Waldorf education that started in the autumn 2005. Apart from the permanent educational work Foldsæ is also a place for development work, school camps, conferences and workshops related to sustainability, ecology and anthroposophy.

Foldsæ lies in the valley of Fyresdal in the beautiful mountainous region of Telemark in the middle of southern Norway. If you have heard about “The dream song of Olav Åsteson», this is the area where it was found.

Behind the campus the property stretches up into the mountains, and thus gives the students possibilities for many kinds of practical learning related to nature.
